

Sometimes I'm in Capable, and I go there more often as I'm getting older.


One of my favorite places to be in is Suspense! It really gets the adrenaline flowing and pumps up the old heart! At my age I need all the stimuli I can get!

Judy has one adopted son, David, who is now married to his lovely bride, Taise, and he fills his time studying business administration.


